

Planning for School Operations for the 2020-2021 School Year *Draft*

This framework provides general guidance on in person instruction and school operations based on the changing circumstances associated with the health pandemic. If Social Distancing is in place, about 50% of students can be on campus at the same time. It is given that in each level, all **requirements** from health and government agencies will be followed. Level movement is fluid and dependent on health orders/guidelines and direction by the Board of Education. Details on bullet points will be developed by appropriate departments/committees.

- School facilities closed to the public
 - Order from authorized agency or Board Decision



- Hybrid Learning
In person and Distance Learning**
- 50% of students at school at one time
 - Optional All Distance Learning
 - Social Distancing
 - Frequent Disinfecting
 - Temperature checks
 - Hand washing/sanitization
 - Masks optional unless required by authorized agency
 - Limited transportation
 - Limited size of gatherings
 - Modified meal service
 - Some sports possible



- In-person Learning
Full time**
- All students on campus together
 - Optional All Distance Learning
 - Frequent disinfecting
 - Hand washing/sanitization
 - Restrictions on gatherings, guests, field trips
 - Some sports possible



- In-person Learning
Full Time**
- No restrictions
 - Optional All Distance Learning
 - Continued focus on proactive health measures
